



Maintenance of a Polished Floor

Maintenance of a Polished Floor

A polished concrete floor is quite durable, but everyday traffic, wear, and spills can interfere with the lasting sheen if the floor is not properly maintained. Soaps and brushes that are too abrasive will dull the shine of a polished floor very quickly. Choosing products that are specifically designed for polished concrete floors will ensure the maximum longevity for the surface.

Daily Cleaning Schedule

Maintenance is an important factor for your clients to understand to sustain the sheen of their polished floor. Daily removal of dirt, oil, and debris will extend the life of the floor. A daily schedule of cleaning either with an autoscrubber (with a soft poly brush) and/or sweeping using a gritless compound agent and a dust mop will give optimal results.

Weekly Cleaning Schedule

Using a soap specifically designed for polished floors will help remove any soils and maintain the luster of the floor.

To add additional longevity to the floors, weekly burnishing using a high speed burnisher can also revitalize the shine.

Monthly Cleaning or As Needed

Degreasing the floor monthly, and as needed for soils, will prevent the surface from being dulled. Use a degreaser specifically designed for polished concrete to ensure the solvent will not dull the shine of the floor.

Annual Maintenance

Reapplication of a sealant annually is recommended to provide maximum security for the surface against staining and abrasives.
